1. **ENTRY FEE:** \$200.00 PER BOAT. Includes all place money (Including Guys & Gals Division) along with 1 Big Bass overall. All **ACTIVE** Military & First Responders get a \$25.00 discount on entries. Entries will be accepted by mail until Wednesday October 21, 2026, & online until 5:00 P.M. Thursday October 22, 2026. You can also register on Friday October 23, 2026 @ the registration tent @ PB2 Tournament Headquarters from 10:00A.M. to 7:30 P.M. & the morning of the tournament Saturday October 24, 2026 from 5:30 A.M. to 7:00 A.M. @ the registration tent @ PB2 Tournament Headquarters. There will be a \$25.00 late fee for all entries accepted at the Registration Table and must be paid in either CASH OR CREDIT CARD. **ABSOLUTELY NO CHECKS ACCEPTED AT THE REGISTRATION TABLE!**
2. **REGISTRATION:** If you entered by mail or on-line you still are **Required to REGISTER** @ the tent on Friday or Saturday morning @ PB2 Tournament Headquarters. (See Above Times For Registration.) **At registration you will receive your official boat number & flight time.** There will be a complimentary FISH FRY on Friday October 23, 2026 starting @ 4:30P.M. til 7:00P.M.
3. **NO REFUNDS::** Unless the tournament is cancelled there will be **NO REFUNDS!** Read the rules carefully before entering.
4. **TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE:** The tournament committee shall have sole authority to interpret the rules and to apply the rules to all issues, disputes, questions or controversies concerning the tournament. All decisions made by the Tournament Committee concerning the tournament, the interpretation of the rules or the rules or awarding of prizes shall be final and not subject to dispute or appeal. The tournament committee reserves the right to reject any entry.
5. **ELIGIBILITY**
 - A. All individuals 18 years of age or older with a paid entry fee (fishing partner does not have to be 18 years of age).
 - B. **NO GUIDES.**
 - C. No team that has earned (combined) more than \$10,000.00 in money within 364 days prior to the tournament date. This excludes all Fish for Sight earnings & this also excludes boats won in a raffle or drawings & certificates.
 - D. Tournament participants must have a valid 2026 Missouri fishing license.
6. **PRE-FISHING RULES:** NO CONTESTANT IS ALLOWED TO FISH WITH A GUIDE DURING THE FIVE (5) DAYS PRIOR TO THE TOURNAMENT.
7. **SAFETY & SPORTSMANSHIP:** Safe boating and fishing practices must be observed at all times. All boats and motors must comply with the MISSOURI WATER PATROL SAFETY & REGULATION RULES. Life jackets & kill switches must be used any time the combustion motor is running above an idle. All contestants are required to follow the highest degree of sportsmanship, courtesy, and conservation. Any team that receives a Water Patrol or Department of Conservation ticket of any kind during tournament hours is automatically disqualified. No alcohol or controlled substance can be used or allowed in the boat during the tournament hours.
8. **TACKLE & EQUIPMENT:** Only artificial bait/ lures are allowed . Pork style baits are allowed. All bass must be caught alive on a rod & reel. Only one rod and reel can be used at any time by any one angler. Alabama/Umbrella rigs are allowed. No trolling allowed. All fishing including the landing of fish shall be done from the boat.
9. **FISHING LOCATIONS:** Anywhere on the Lake of the Ozarks except within the NO WAKE BUOYS at the coves of PB2 & PA HE TSI. There will be NO TRAILERING of boats with fish during tournament hours. Your partner may bring the trailer to the weigh-in site, but the fish must be transported by you in your boat by water to the weigh-in site.
10. **TOURNAMENT HOURS:** 7:00 A.M. until 3:00 P.M.
11. **TAKE OFF:** You may start from anywhere on the Lake of the Ozarks. Your time to start fishing (lines in the water) will be determined by your boat number & flight. These are 40 boat flights. Flight one (lines in the water 7:00 A.M.) Flight two (lines in the water 7:15 A.M.) Flight three (lines in the water 7:30 A.M.) Flight four (lines in the water 7:45 A.M.).
12. **WEIGH-IN:** The scales will be opening early at 2:00 P.M. @ PB2. If you choose to weigh-in @ 2:00 P.M. you are done fishing. Your required time to be back is by your start time. Flight one back at 3:00 P.M. Flight two back @ 3:15 P.M. Flight three back at 3:30 P.M. Flight four back at 3:45 P.M.. Participants late in checking back in will be disqualified. There will be no grace period, No Exceptions. The scale will close Thirty Minutes after the last flight is due in.
13. **WEIGH-IN BAGS:** All fish must be brought to the scales in a weigh-in bag provided by the tournament, do not use your personal bag. Weigh-in bags will be located next to the tournament trailer. If none are available, please wait in line until the next one is available. Thank You!
14. **SCORING: 5 FISH LIMIT**
All Largemouth /Smallmouth / Kentucky(spotted) will be scored & must be a minimum of 15 inches in length.
Short fish will result in a one (1) pound penalty plus the loss of the fish. A dead fish will result in a one (1) pound penalty per fish. If the dead fish is weighed in for Big Bass, the (1) pound will be deducted from that fish. Culling of a dead bass is prohibited.
No more than 5 fish are allowed in your live-well at any time, unless it is during the culling process. Anyone bringing more than five (5) fish to the bump tub will not be allowed to weigh in any fish.
No culling allowed inside the bouys @ PB 2.
All fish weighed in must be caught during the official tournament hours.
The official Weigh Master will make the final decisions on all short & dead fish / frozen or mangled fish.
15. **POLYGRAPH TEST:** Each contestant agrees by virtue of their participation in the tournament agrees to submit to a polygraph test if requested to do so by the Tournament Chairman. Anyone failing the test or refusing to take the test will be disqualified.
16. **PROTEST:** All protest must be submitted in writing to the tournament director within (5) minutes of the closing of the scales. The appointed tournament advisory board will handle all protest. The decision of the tournament director shall be final in all matters.
17. **TIES:** All ties, the winner will be determined by the lower boat number.
18. **WAIVER:** Through your entry fee, you waive and release all other contestants , the host, sponsor, the charity and tournament officials from all claims and/or damage incurred in connection with this tournament.
19. **BOAT BREAKDOWN:** In the event of a boat breakdown, the team may transfer their fish to another contestant's boat for transport to the weigh-in site, meeting the following conditions: The fish must be placed in a segregated live-well. One member of the breakdown team must always accompany those fish to the weigh-in site. The team broken down must stop fishing from the time of transfer.
